

# 2010 WRS FAQ's

#### Rain

Well, let's hope not. But if it does rain, snow or whatever, here is how to best prepare. We will ride, rain or shine! Dress in layers and put on your best rain gear. Bring extra clothes with you, in case you do get wet. Avoid cotton garments and look for "wicking" wear. Staying dry and comfortable means having a fun day of learning. Being wet, cold and miserable generally means you aren't having fun - and neither are we.

For good vision, try Pledge (Judy's favorite) or Rain-X (or any "wax" product) on your face shield to keep the water beading up and rolling off. You can learn a lot when riding in the rain. You have to be smooth in the wet and that translates to riding smooth in the dry -- which only makes you a much better rider.

While we can't promise you the sun, we can certainly promise that, if you take your riding lessons seriously, you will be a better rider.

# **What To Bring**

Besides yourself, your motorcycle and your protective gear and helmet, there are a few other things that can make your day more fun and relaxing.

**Earplugs** 

Full fuel can

Change of clothes, socks, sneakers

Shower stuff (we do have access to the showers)

Sunglasses, lotion and hat

Rain gear (if inclement weather is possible)

Blue painter's tape (highly recommended) and/or duct tape

Tools: Tire pressure gauge

Spare motorcycle key

Pen and clipboard (for note-taking)

Folding chair (for relaxing in the pit garage)

Camera (for personal pics)

Health insurance card (just in case)

## Where can family and friends roam during the WRS?

Family and friends can feel free to "hang out" in the pit garage area all day. They can snap photos and walk or **bicycle** around the entire spectator area of NHMS' racecourse - inside or outside the tunnel area. They even have access to the



stands. The Turn 6 (a.k.a. the "bowl") stands are a popular place for spectators to snap photos. Enter them by leaving the tunnel and turning left.

### \*Note: Gated Areas

Do not enter any gated area without permission from one of our staff. <u>No one</u> under the age of 18 is allowed inside the gated areas.

#### Can children come with me?

Children of any age must be supervised while at our event. Please do not allow your child to go unsupervised.

### Food

Please remember that any food provided by the WRS is for our paying customers. Your guests are on their own for snacks, drinks and food. Your guests will need to bring their own food. If they don't, there are convenient stores close-by.

#### **Pets**

We discourage riders from bringing their pets to the event. We will not/cannot be responsible for your animal(s). Your pet cannot be in the pit garages or near our event area. Pets must be kept on a leash. Our first concern is for the safety of our Riding School Participants.

### First Aid

Medical assessment/treatment you receive while at NHMS is included in your WRS fee. If you need an ice pack, band-aid - whatever - just stop in the In-field Infirmary. If you require transportation to the hospital, the costs (including your ride to the hospital) are your responsibility. Make certain your medical insurance is up-to-date.
